St. Paul United Methodist Church has several years' experience in running one of the largest tax preparation sites in the Dayton area. At this time, we have 5 experienced volunteer tax preparers who are offering appointments weekdays during the morning, afternoon and evening in order to accommodate as many people as possible. Vicki Morris, our program coordinator, will set you up with an appointment by calling the church at 252-4467.

A Tax Clinic is being offered on Saturday, January 30 from 11am until 2pm. The tax preparers will do people's taxes on a first come, first serve basis.

Hispanic Ministry Update

LAS POSADAS, a traditional Mexican Christmas celebration is held annually at St. Paul UMC. The 2015 event was a big success, with more than 50 people in attendance.

Members of our Hispanic community helped to organize the event, and did a beautiful job with the pageant. After the Service, all were invited to a traditional Mexican Christmas feast, complete with piñatas for the children. For the first time ever, thanks to a special donation from the Life Enrichment Center, three excited children received a brand new bicycle!

Thank you to all of our donors and to the West Ohio Conference for helping to support this ministry because, without you, none of this would be possible.

In addition to our regular Las Amigas program, which is a HIspanic women's support group connected with United Methodist Women, we began to offer a **Sunday evening Blble Study and Worship Service in Spanish** starting on January 3, 2016. We are excited about the potential for transformation and growth through this ministry.

Special thanks to Francia and Darrell Moore, leaders with the Esperanza Viva Hispanic Ministry in Mason, Ohio, for helping us to develop a Spanish Worship Service at St. Paul. Francia is a native of Colombia, South America, and is a good role model for our women. Darrell's talents as a guitarist and as a former school teacher are a valuable addition to our programs. For the first time ever, we have not just babysitters for the children, but someone who is able to help them grow spiritually as well.


